Grade Levels: 11, 12

A Call to Stand Apart is a modern paraphrase of Ellen White's writings prepared especially for young adults. Section 1: "Just Jesus and You" begins with the birth of Jesus and concludes with His death and resurrection. Section 2: "Just Jesus in Your Life" is topical and deals with issues relevant to young people today. The table on the next page lists chapter titles.

A Call to Stand Apart may be used on its own in the classroom or in conjunction with the NAD curriculum. For those who decide to use this book on its own, section one provides a good chronological overview of Jesus' life. For those who wish to use the book as a supplement to the NAD curriculum, the contents table also contains suggestions as to where the chapters in this book would be best suited.
